

Enrico Giacobelli is an architect and founding partner in 1985 of G-Studio, whose activity (in Italy and abroad) concerns the development of residential projects, high-rise buildings, healthcare and industrial facilities, and the restoration of modern buildings.

Parallel to his professional activity, E.G. carries out research and teaching activities in the university and non-university fields, contributing to orienting G-Studio's professional activity towards themes of architectural theme contextualisation, respect for the historical value of the built environment and sustainability.

G-studio's professional activity has long been intertwined with the project for the better knowledge, preservation and valorisation of modern constructions realised by the Olivetti company in Ivrea, a theme around which E.G.'s activity has been developing since 1995 with research, consultancy, cultural animation and recovery and restoration projects.

E.G. was a member of the National Committee for the commemoration of the centenary of the founding of the Olivetti company; he is a member of the Do.Co.Mo.Mo- International; coordinator of the "Restoration, Recovery and Conservation" Focus of the Order of Architects of Turin, contract lecturer in Architectural Composition at the Faculty of Architecture of the Politecnico di Torino since 2007, coordinator and lecturer of the "International Summer School of Ivrea" (Summer School of the Politecnico di Milano) between 2007 and 2013.
